



Letter of Recommendation

A letter of recommendation is required for veterinary technicians registering for the Certified Canine Rehabilitation Assistant Program who do not have formal credentials. This letter must be on practice letterhead and written by the applicant's supervising veterinarian or physical therapist.

The following information should be included in the letter:

- Name, credentials and contact information for the person providing the letter of recommendation
- Name of applicant
- How long the applicant has worked as a veterinary technician
- How long the applicant has worked at the practice
- Applicant's understanding of the following:
 - Canine anatomy and biomechanics
 - Common orthopedic conditions, procedures, and acronyms
 - Common neurological presentations and surgeries
- Applicant's experience handling client education
- Applicant's ability to handle the rigors of the CCRA program and to commit to putting in the time to study and practice new techniques
- Any other comments about the applicant's suitability for CCRA program
